







Activities 1, 2, 3 and 4 test recognition of vocabulary in the following sets: numbers 1–10, colours, the weather and family members.

- 1 Listen and circle. (Track D:1)

Teaching notes

Award one point per item for accuracy and one point for ability to communicate clearly.

Activity 5 asks students to produce parts of the body vocabulary.

Point to the girl's hand and say *hand*. Ask students to point to one of their hands. Repeat with another part of the body, then have students point to a part of the body in the picture and themselves and name it. Challenge students to each name five parts of the body.

Activity 6 asks students to produce vocabulary in the following sets: animals, toys, transport, food, clothes, nature, the weather.

I can see a horse. I can see burgers.

Read the example sentences and ask students to repeat them and point to the items in the picture. Challenge students to each say five more things they can see in the picture.

Example answers: eyes, ears, mouth, nose, feet, legs, arms, fingers, toes, head, hair.

6 What can you see? Say.

Example answers: I can see ... a cat / a dog / a fish / a teddy / a ball / a bike / a cake / chips / juice / milk / a hat / T-shirts / trees / flowers / rocks / the sun / it's sunny / it's hot.
